### About Journal of Network Industries

Intersentia and the editorial board invite papers for *Journal of Network Industries*. This outstanding multidisciplinary journal focuses on the legal, economic, institutional and public policy aspects of network industries – here defined as any industry whose operations rely on networks or present characteristics associated with them, from traditional utilities such as the provision of telecommunications services or the distribution of electricity and gas to recent innovations (such as electronic payment systems) that represent some of the fastest-growing sectors of today's growing economy.

The *Journal of Network Industries* emphasizes the dominant current trends and issues affecting network-based and network-related, such as following:

- the global shift from monopoly to competition in public utilities, including important issues of access to network infrastructure by new entrants;
- new problems surrounding the right of all citizens to access to basic public services;
- the tendency of this sector of the economy to raise fundamental questions about the institutional aspects of regulation; and
- the continuing expansion of the large and relatively unmapped legal and economic zone around communications industries of all kinds.

As the complex industries and their regulatory environments evolve, the *Journal of Network Industries* will continue to provide researchers, lawyers, government officials, regulators, jurists, corporate executives, and officials in international organizations with a valuable forum for exchange and debate. The *Journal of Network Industries* encourages studies including one or several comparative dimensions.
